- E7:** Open strings on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd frets, 4th, 5th, and 6th strings.
- A:** Open strings on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd frets, 4th, 5th, and 6th strings.
- D7:** Open strings on 1st, 2nd, and 3rd frets, 4th, 5th, and 6th strings.
- F#:** 1st fret on 1st string, 2nd fret on 2nd string, 3rd fret on 3rd string, 4th fret on 4th string, 5th fret on 5th string.
